**Uniform Policy**

At Lodge Farm, we want children to be proud of our school and to wear the correct uniform. The uniform is simple, but smart. It helps the children to identify with each other and with our local community. All uniform should be clearly named to ensure it does not get lost or misplaced. If children are not wearing correct uniform a phone call to parents will be made to ensure that this is corrected and any support needed with this will be put in place.

## **Pre-loved uniform:**

We know that uniform can be expensive, therefore a range of pre-loved uniform is available to all in school. We try to bring this uniform out at various school events so before buying new uniform, do consider using this option.

## **Lodge Farm uniform**

All children are to wear:

- White collared shirt or polo shirt
- Grey trousers, tailored knee-length shorts, skirt or pinafore dress
- > A blue and white checked dress is optional in warmer weather
- Navy blue, long-sleeved jumper/sweatshirt/fleece/cardigan (no hoodies or logos with the exception of the school logo)
- ➤ Headwear should be in line with school colours
- Sensible black shoes/sandals/trainers
- Wellingtons can be worn in inclement weather but a change of shoes should be provided
- > Stud earrings only. These are to be removed or covered for PE days
- ➤ No make-up, including nail varnish
- Long hair should be tied back fully
- Watches and step counters may be worn, but these should not have text or recording features
- Nursery and Reception children need to have a pair of wellingtons and a waterproof for outdoor play

## PE kit

All children are to wear:

- ➢ Blue PE t-shirt
- Navy shorts
- Navy joggers and navy sweatshirt in winter without logos unless it is the school logo.
- Trainers
- No jewellery stud earrings must be covered on PE days
